What width and length grain bags do you have?

Our Plastar grain bags are 9 or 10 feet in width and range anywhere from 200 to 500 feet in length, depending on availability.

What thickness are the bags?

We offer Plastar premium grain bags that are 9.3 mil in thickness. Our Plastar grain bags have been tested by the state of Missouri.

How many bushels will a bag hold?

9ft Plastar grain bags will hold approx. 40 bushels per foot, 10ft Plastar grain bags will hold approx. 50 bushels per foot.

How much do bags cost?

Our Plastar grain bags cost roughly 0.7 cents a bushel.



What moisture can I store my grain at in grain bags?

See Chart below for general guidelines.



Risk in relation to grain moisture

Grain	Low (*)	Med/Low	Med/High
Soy, Corn, Wheat	Up to 14%	14-16%	Greater than 16%
Sunflower	Up to 11%	11-14%	Greater than 14%

(*) For seed grain these values must be lowered by 1-2%

Risk in relation to storage time

Grain/Moisture Content	Low (*)	Med/Low	Med/High
Soy, corn, wheat 14% Sunflower 11%	6 months	12 months	18 months
Soy, corn, wheat 14%	2 months	6 months	12 months
Soy, Corn, wheat over 16%	1 month	2 months	3 months

How long can I store my grain in grain bags?

Plastar grain bags are designed to store grain up to 24 months.
